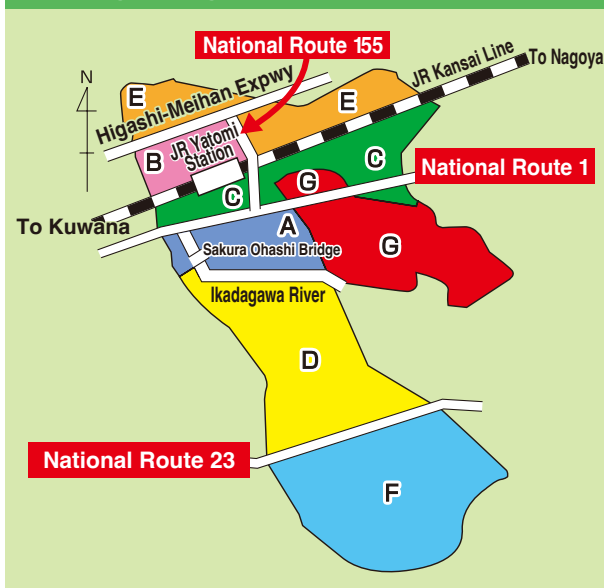


General Household Garbage Collection Schedule in Yatomi City

When the weather is bad

If garbage bags, etc. are taken out in bad weather conditions, they may be blown away by strong winds, making them unsanitary or impossible to collect.

In such a situation, please refrain from taking out garbage. The containers to collect plastic bottles may be temporarily removed when a typhoon is approaching.



⚠ Please do not take out business-related garbage

- **Any waste generated as a result of business activities in restaurants, shops, offices, factories, etc. is classified as business-related garbage and will not be collected by Yatomi City.**
- The disposal of such garbage must be entrusted to service providers authorized to collect and transport waste by Yatomi City. Alternatively, you can deliver such garbage directly to Hachiho Clean Center after making a prior application. (Industrial waste is excluded.)

About service providers authorized to dispose of industrial waste


















When you take out household garbage, please separate it by type, and put it in the garbage bags designated by Yatomi City. When you take out bulky waste, please affix bulky waste collection coupons to it.

Any garbage that is put in bags not designated by Yatomi City or separated improperly will not be collected.

You can purchase garbage bags designated by Yatomi City and bulky waste collection coupons at shops such as supermarkets and drug stores.

Combustible waste ★ Food waste ★ Waste paper ★ Plants ★ Leather products ★ Cloth ★ Rubber	Edible oil, tea leaves, food waste, paper packs (with a silver-colored inner surface), paper cups, ice packs, clothing, shoes (made of cloth, leather or vinyl), boots, wallets, belts, bags (made of cloth, leather or nylon), cushions, carpets, electrically heated carpets, electrically heated blankets, ice pillows, diapers (put them in a bag after flushing the human waste in a toilet, and tie the bag), pet toilet sand, dehumidifiers, vinyl sheets, charcoal (wet it enough with water), waste paper, waste wood, garden trees (those which are 60 cm or taller are categorized as bulky waste), grass and flowers, stuffed animals, wooden toys, balls (for sports), etc.	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If an item is too big to tie the mouth of the garbage bag containing it, it must be put out as bulky waste. • Please drain the water from food waste before taking it out. • When taking out waste oil such as edible oil, it must be soaked in paper, cloth, etc. • Garbage, such as bags, can be put out as combustible waste even if it contains some metal fittings. 
Plastic waste ★ Garbage made mostly of plastic	Plastic bags, shopping bags, exterior film, styrene foam, urethane products, sweets and bread bags, food trays, ketchup and mayonnaise containers, instant noodle containers, toothbrushes, detergent containers, sponges, vinyl scrubbers, buckets, vinyl hoses (cut them into about 1.5 m long sections), poly tanks, plastic buckets, storage boxes for clothing, air cushions, toilet seats, ballpoint pens, ink cartridges, etc.	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If an item is too big to tie the mouth of the garbage bag containing it, it must be put out as bulky waste. • Please make sure to clean and empty containers before taking them out. • Food trays can be alternatively put in the collection boxes at supermarkets and other stores. • Please take out plastic bottles and caps in the collection containers in nearby public facilities (City Hall, Jushiya Branch Office, Shiratori Community Center, and Nanbu Community Center), etc. 
Non-combustible waste ★ Metal ★ Glass ★ Pottery	Broken fluorescent tubes, glass, cosmetic bottles, dishes, cooking pans, frying pans, pots, kettles, kitchen knives, can lids, aluminum products, irons, microwave ovens, toaster ovens, hot plates, air purifiers, humidifiers, lighting devices, LED fluorescent tubes, dehumidifiers, light bulbs, vacuum cleaners, printers, toilet seats with washing function, AC adapters, extension cords, gas stoves, gas heaters, lighters (use up the fuel first), coolers, metal buckets, scissors, utility knives, nails, adhesives, paint cans (use up the contents first), desiccant, insect repellent, disposable warm pads, mirrors, umbrellas, metal toys, watches, cameras, golf balls, spiked shoes, bicycle tires and tubes, helmets, etc.	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If an item is too big to tie the mouth of the garbage bag containing it, it must be put out as bulky waste. However, umbrellas will be collected even if some part is out of the bag. • Please put out fluorescent tubes that are not broken as recyclables. • Please wrap broken items and knives with cloth or paper before taking them out. • Please remove any battery cells and rechargeable batteries from the items to be taken out. • When taking out small home appliances, please put them in collection boxes at City Hall and Jushiya Branch Office if possible. (See "Small home appliances" on page 3.) • If possible, please bring glass and pottery directly to the Hachiho Clean Center. 
Bulky waste	Spring mattresses (it is necessary to contact the Environment Division), beds, tables, desks, chairs, sofas, legless chairs, shelves, TV stands, strollers, child seats, suitcases, bicycles (excluding motor-assisted bicycles), guitars, organs, golf clubs, golf bags, surfboards (2 m or shorter only), skis, tents, barbecue sets, tin plates, etc.	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please affix a waste collection coupon designated by Yatomi City (green sticker) to each item of bulky waste. The coupons can be purchased at the places where the designated garbage bags are sold. • Bulky waste is not collected if all three of its dimensions (length, width, height) exceed 1.5 m. • Please empty golf bags and storage boxes for clothing before taking them out. • Up to 10 golf clubs can be taken out with one coupon. • When a futon is taken out, the cover and the mattress can also be taken out with one coupon. • When taking out knockdown furniture, etc. after disassembly, please tie the pieces with string. • When taking out spring mattresses, contact the Environmental Division in advance to inform it of the collection site to deliver them to and the date. 

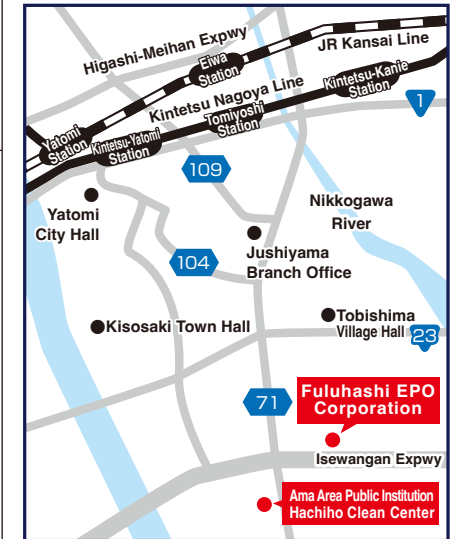

<h2 style="text-align: center;">Recyclables</h2>	<p>Empty cans (yellow or blue containers depending on the type)</p> <p>Items in this category: Beverage cans, food cans, spray cans, and cassette-type gas cylinders</p> <p>How to take them out: Empty the items and place them in the containers at the designated resource storage area (yellow containers for spray cans and cassette-type gas cylinders and blue containers for the others)</p> <p>Note: Paint cans and oil cans must be put out as non-combustible waste after their contents are used up.</p> <p>There is no need to pierce spray cans before taking them out.</p> 	<p>Empty bottles (blue container)</p> <p>Items in this category: Liquor, beverages, food, and seasoning bottles</p> <p>How to take them out: Remove the caps, wash the items lightly, sort them by color (colorless/transparent, brown, blue/green and black), and place them in blue baskets at the designated resource storage area.</p> <p>Note: Please return beer bottles and other returnable bottles to the distributors. Pottery containing alcoholic beverages must be put out as non-combustible waste.</p> 	<p>Fluorescent tubes (gray container)</p> <p>Items in this category: Straight, ring, compact and spherical fluorescent tubes discharged from households</p> <p>How to take them out: Take tubes out of wrapping paper, etc. without breaking them, and place them in gray baskets for fluorescent tubes at the designated resource storage area.</p> <p>Note: LED fluorescent tubes, electric bulbs, halogen lamps, mercury lamps and glow bulbs must be put out as non-combustible waste.</p> <p>Broken fluorescent tubes must be wrapped in paper or cloth and put out as non-combustible waste.</p> 	<p>Paper and cloth</p> <p>Items in this category: Newspapers, leaflets, magazines, confectionery boxes, paper bags, etc., cardboard boxes, milk cartons, cotton products, clothing, blankets, curtains, etc. that use chemical fibers</p> <p>How to take them out: Paper items must be sorted by type and tied up crosswise with string. Cloth items must be put in transparent or translucent bags other than garbage bags designated by Yatomi City to take them out.</p> <p>Note: Dirty items must be taken out as combustible waste.</p> <p>Before taking out milk cartons, they must be washed lightly, dried, cut open and then tied with string.</p> 
	<h2 style="text-align: center;">Small home appliances</h2>	<p>Digital cameras, smartphones, portable music players, game consoles, remote controllers, AC adapters, and cables</p> <p>Places for collection: City Hall (south entrance of the main building) and Jushiyama Branch Office (in front of the toilet)</p> <p>Collection time: From 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. on operating days</p> <p>Note: The items must be small enough to be put into the collection boxes. (The dimensions of the inlet: 12cm high×37cm wide×40cm deep)</p> <p>Any battery cells and rechargeable batteries must be removed and put into the respective collection boxes.</p>		
<h2 style="text-align: center;">Items regulated by the Home Appliance Recycling Law</h2>	<p>For the disposal of TV sets, air conditioners, washing machines (drying machines), and refrigerators (freezers), please contact the distributor or Home Appliance Recycling Coupon Center (0120-319-640).</p>			
<h2 style="text-align: center;">PCs</h2>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> ① Please contact the manufacturer. PCs with the PC recycling mark will be collected by the manufacturers free of charge. ② For home-built PCs, products of manufacturers that have gone bankrupt or withdrawn from the business, and PCs imported personally, please apply to PC3R Promotion Association (03-5282-7685). ③ Please apply to ReNet Japan Recycling Co., Ltd. (0570-085-800). 			

Direct delivery of garbage

You can take garbage directly to Hachiho Clean Center (incineration plant).
Hachiho Clean Center, 399-3 Happo, Nabeta-cho, Yatomi From Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:45 p.m.

- ① Make an application at the reception of the Environment Division, and sort the garbage and bring it to the center by car. ID is required.
- ② A delivery instruction document will be issued after the garbage is checked. (The document is valid for the day of issue only.)
- ③ Present the delivery instruction document at the reception of the clean center and take out the garbage.
- ④ After the garbage is collected, please pay the fee in cash (200 yen per 10 kg).

[Note] Recyclables will not be collected. The dimensions of an item must be within 2 m x 1.5 m x 2 m. For trees, the diameter and length must be 25 cm and 1.5 m or less, respectively.



Direct delivery of weeded grass, thinned branches, etc.

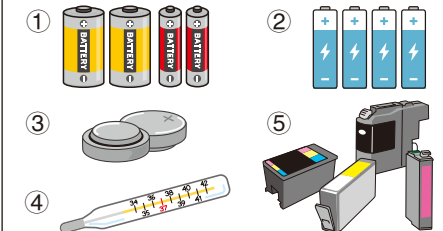
You can take weeded grass, thinned branches, etc. directly to Fuluhashi EPO Corporation.

Monday to Friday 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (reception ends at 5:30 p.m.)
Saturday and holidays 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. (reception ends at 4:30 p.m.)

- ① Make an application at the reception of the Environment Division
- ② A delivery instruction document will be issued. * The document is valid from the day of issue to the Saturday of that week.
- ③ Present the delivery instruction document at Fuluhashi EPO and take out weeded grass, thinned branches, etc.
- ④ After the garbage is collected, please pay the fee in cash (weeded grass and bamboo: 20 yen per kg, bushes, trunks, branches, and leaves: 15 yen per kg [tax excluded]).

[Note] Make sure to remove any dirt and sand.
 If the garbage is put in bags, etc., take out the contents and take the bags, etc. with you.
 Preservative-treated timber, termite-proof timber or timber damaged by termite may not be disposed of.
 When different types of garbage are mixed, a higher rate will be applied.
 If any item that is not to be collected is included in the garbage, you cannot dispose of the garbage.

Other

- ① Dry cells (manganese, alkaline): Put them in the collection boxes placed in City Hall, Jushiyama Branch Office, etc.
- ② Small rechargeable batteries (lithium-ion batteries, nickel hydride batteries, and nickel-cadmium batteries): Put them in the collection boxes placed in City Hall, Jushiyama Branch Office, etc.
- ③ Button batteries: Collected by partner shops in the city
- ④ Mercury thermometers: Collected at the counter of the Environment Division in City Hall
- ⑤ Ink cartridges: Collected in City Hall and Jushiyama Branch Office



Items NOT collected by Yatomi City

- ① Business-related garbage: See "Please do not take out business-related garbage" on page 1.
- ② TV sets, air conditioners, washing machines (drying machines) and refrigerators (freezers): See "Items regulated by the Home Appliance Recycling Law" on page 3.
- ③ PCs: See "PCs" on page 3.
- ④ Garbage that is difficult to dispose of (automobile parts, tires, motors, motorcycles, pesticides, agricultural instruments, greenhouse vinyl sheets, propane gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, chemicals, paints, etc.): Please consult the retailer or a specialty shop.
